Do you have credit from a college or university? Do you want to transfer to OSU? You can choose to transfer direct to OSU or take advantage of our unique, individualized Undergraduate Transfer Program.

## Transfer Overview

Have you earned credits from another college or university? You can transfer directly to OSU if you meet all requirements, but you also have the option of selecting a UTP. Our UTP provides a customized path to earning your bachelor's degree at OSU. **You won't repeat course work and will receive additional academic, language and cultural support to help you excel at a US university.** This program has four start dates available: Fall, Winter, Spring and Summer.

- Guaranteed progression to any OSU undergraduate program upon successful completion of your UTP

## Average number of credits accepted for Washington, California & Oregon

- Students who complete two years of coursework at a community college typically transfer 90 credits to OSU (equivalent to two full academic years).
- Students who complete one year of coursework at a community college typically transfer 45 credits to OSU (equivalent to one full academic year).

Amount - \$6,000 / year, up to 4 years  
Requirement - 3.5 Transfer GPA

Amount - Approximately \$15,000 / year  
Requirements - 3.0 Transfer GPA
