Do you have credit from a college or university? Do you want to transfer to OSU? You can choose to transfer direct to OSU or take advantage of our unique, individualized Undergraduate Transfer Program.

Transfer Overview

Have you earned credits from another college or university? You can transfer directly to OSU if you meet all requirements, but you also have the option of selecting a UTP. Our UTP provides a customized path to earning your bachelor's degree at OSU. You won't repeat course work and will receive additional academic, language and cultural support to help you excel at a US university. This program has four start dates available: Fall, Winter, Spring and Summer.

Average number of credits accepted for Washington, California & Oregon

- Students who complete two years of coursework at a community college typically transfer 90 credits to OSU (equivalent to two full academic years).
- Students who complete one year of coursework at a community college typically transfer 45 credits to OSU (equivalent to one full academic year).
